

# CSU General Education Requirements 2020

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## TO TRANSFER

A student must:

- x Complete 60 semester/90 quarter transferable units including a minimum of 30 semester/45 quarter units in general education courses with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- x Complete Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 with a grade of C or higher in each course
- x Be in good standing at the last college or university attended, and have completed or made up any missing college preparatory subject requirements.

Prior to transfer, it is strongly recommended that students complete the CSU GE pattern in full including the American Institution graduation requirement. Certain programs have more applicants than there are spaces available. These "impacted programs" have additional screening requirements. ## CSU General Education Transfer Curriculum Requirements

Students may follow the pattern of study outlined below or, the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) meet lower division general education requirements for the CSU system.

- x SMC does not accept foreign coursework from non-U.S. regionally accredited institutions to meet CSU GE requirements.
- x Important: Courses in Areas A1, A2, A3, and B4 must be completed with a grade of C or higher in each course

## Credit by Exam: International Baccalaureate (IB) Exams

x A score of 5, 6 or 7 on Higher Level (HL) exams is required to grant credit for IGETC certification.

x An acceptable IB score for IGETC equates to either 3 semester/4 quarter units for certification purposes.

x For transfer purposes, UC will grant 5.3 semester/8 quarter units for an exam completed with a score of 5, 6 or 7 on HL exam.
