General Education (GE) consists of courses selected from a variet of disciplines, intended to provide a well-rounded education. Completing a GE pattern is one of the components for transfer to any CSU. Other transfer components include grade point average and preparation for the major coursework. Please visit the Transfer Center or Counseling Office to obtain all the requirements for transfer to a CSU.

GOLDEN FOUR: Areas – A1, A2, A3 and B4 are required for admission into any CSU. CSU campuses require letter grades of "C" or better for graduation. Please consult with a counselor for details regarding grades of "P".
