QUALIFICATIONS: Ph.D. or Master's degree in communication disorders, and academic and practical expertise. University teaching experience is preferred. In addition, candidates seeking employment in our credential program must have: a) current knowledge of the content they teach/supervise; b) knowledge of the current context of public schooling including California's adopted P12 content standards, framework, and accountability system; c) knowledge of diversity in society, including diverse abilities, culture, language, ethnicity, and gender orientation; and d) demonstration of effective professional practices in teaching and learning, scholarship, and service.
